In this work, a visual image (circle) is created by means of a material structure (accumulation of color) and mirror reflection (phenomenon) that define the process of creation (time). It expresses my gaze that perceives the intrinsic richness in the accumulation of material, information, experience, and time (past) that supports the superficial image (present).
